

Dorzolamide

(CoSopt*, Dorzolamide*, Dorzolamide with Timolol*, Trusopt*) POM

- **Formulations**

Ophthalmic drops: 20 mg/ml (2%) (Trusopt), 2% dorzolamide + 0.5% timolol (CoSopt); 5 ml bottle, single-use vials (CoSopt, Trusopt).

- **Action**

Reduces intraocular pressure (IOP) by reducing the rate of aqueous humour production by inhibiting the formation of bicarbonate ions within the ciliary body epithelium.

- **Use**

In the control of all types of glaucoma in dogs and cats, either alone or in combination with other topicals. Dorzolamide/timolol combination may be more effective in dogs than either drug alone; in cats, maximal IOP lowering efficiency occurs with dorzolamide alone. It may be less tolerated than brinzolamide because of its pH of 5.6.
